



WHAT'S NEW

Reading: This past week, we had a lesson on perspective and how it is important for skilled readers to be able to identify who is speaking but also to consider the effects the speaker's voice has on the plot! We also wrote our Book Club Book Constitutions and determined our Book Club Book pacing! Inquire about your child's required daily reading and plan to ensure they are able to meet that expectation! I am so excited to continue to hear the buzz around these wonderful books and also watch our readers grow their reading skills, stamina, and sharpen their strategies!

Science: This week we continued our lessons in the Web of Life unit! We learned more about food chains, food webs and played a game called "Eat or Be Eaten." Ask your child about their food chains and their score and to make a food chain/web for you! Inquire about the role of the sun and how energy flows through the food chain! Additionally, we reexamined our Biosphere 2 model to ensure we had a source of energy and that our models would be self-staining! If you would like your child to practice making food

chains/webs, here are two games they can play: [1st Food Chain Game](#) and [2nd Food Chain Game](#)

Math: Pioneers strengthened and applied their understanding of multi-digit multiplication and place value in relationships to shifts of powers of 10. Give your student problems to complete-flip card (digits 2-9) and have him make 3 digit * 2 digit problems or 4 digit by 3 digit challenges! (Our test will be bumped to next week! :)
